## **SESSION DETAILS**

### **Session 1**

**1. School Library Disaster Management Planning: Are you prepared?**

What would you do if you came to work and found your library flooded? Or your collection covered in soot and ash? What if pests have taken up residence in your non-fiction collection? Or a roof leak has soaked your graphic novels? If your answer to these questions is 'I don't know', then come join the DoE School Library Support team, as they take you through how to prepare for disasters and what to do when they occur. Discover how to protect your collection in a proactive way with advice from the SLWA team. **HS PS**

**2. Uncover the mysteries of weeding your library collection**

This session will cover aspects applicable to both primary and secondary school libraries. It will commence by unpacking the theories that underpin the role and the process of weeding, why we do it and the strategies for doing so. This will be followed by a hands-on practical activity utilizing the state library collection, where session participants can put their skills into practice, whilst sharing their own experiences with colleagues. This will all be contained in an atmosphere of shared learning and the opportunity to have questions answered. **HS PS**
